## ONE-TIME OPPORTUNITIES FOR GROUPS


**Done-In-A-Day Projects**   
Painting (must be 18 and older), cleaning, organizing or landscaping project at one of our facilities.

**Meal Provider**

**Adopt-a-Day in Pathways**  
Adult groups of 5 - 15 volunteers provide crafts, snacks, activities and fun for our school-age children on days out of school from 9-11:30am and/or 12:45-2:30pm

Men's volunteer groups provide fun opportunities for the Crossroads men on weekends or evenings (e.g. watch a ball game, cards, corn hole tournaments, etc.)

## LAURA'S HOME WOMEN'S CRISIS CENTER

**Childcare Assistant**  
**Weekdays, 9-11:30am & 12:45-2:30pm**  
Assist teacher with daily classroom activities

**Resource Center**  
**Weekday, daytime (hours vary)**  
Assist women with basic computer functions, writing resumes, learning to read, etc.

**Front Desk Support**  
**Daily availability**  
Assist security staff in answering phones, greeting guests, and receiving donations.

**Kitchen Assistant**  
**Weekday, daytime hours available**  
Assist kitchen staff in preparing & serving a meal, and cleaning up

**Library Services**  
**Tues and Wed between 2-5pm**  
Assist women & children with checking out books.

**Salon Services**  
**Weekdays 10am - 5pm**  
Licensed cosmetologists provide basic hair care (wash, cut, color, etc.) services for clients.

## CROSSROADS MEN'S CRISIS CENTER

**Day Room Mentor**  
**Weekday, daytime hours**  
Assist staff member with pre-program class and encourage men.

**Client Safety Support**  
**Daily 3pm - 6pm or 6pm - 9pm**  
Assist security staff with answering phone calls and greeting guests.

**Resource Center**  
**Weekday, daytime (hours vary)**  
Assist men with basic computer functions, writing resumes, learning to read, etc.

**Warehouse Assistant**  
**Mon - Fri between 9am & 4pm**  
Receive and sort donations.

**Support Group Leader**  
**Fri 7pm - 8pm**  
Facilitate group discussion and encourage men in Christ.

**Kitchen Assistant**  
**Weekday, daytime hours available**  
Assist kitchen staff in preparing & serving a meal, and cleaning up.

**Art Cart**  
**Mon - Fri 12:30pm - 1:30pm**  
Engaging men in various arts and crafts to help alleviate stress and anxiety.

## PATHWAYS: SCHOOL-AGE KIDS

**Homework Club**  
**Mon - Fri from 3pm - 5pm**  
Assist with homework and activities during the school year.

**Teen Club Assistant**  
**Tues and Thurs from 7:30pm - 8:30pm**  
Mentor and disciple teenagers during the school year.

**Christian Mentoring**  
**Weekday evenings (times vary based on schedule of mentor/mentee)**  
Mentor a school-aged child for one hour once a week.
